



In partnership with the **Central Quebec School Board**, **LEARN Virtual Summer School** is an option available to the following students this year:

- Students who have already taken the course and who got a final mark over 49 % (or prerequisite credits for bridge courses).
- Students must be approved by their school board.

Where:

- **All classes are offered online** using Zoom and our portal, SAKAI. Students will be provided with Quick Start Guides to help them participate fully.

Evaluation:

- LEARN summer school teachers will provide instruction and assessment. Competency evaluation, where required, will be integrated into class time.
- CQSB students who will be registered with LEARN in the Virtual Summer School will automatically be registered for MEQ exams if applicable. **There's no need to contact CQSB.**
- Feedback and attendance information will be provided to families and school boards during the summer school period
- **Final results will be sent directly to the School Board, not families, at the end of the summer school session.**
 - **Secondary 3 courses: CQSB will produce summer school report cards and will email it to parents.**
 - **Secondary 4 & 5 courses: As of August 13th, Secondary 4 & 5 results will be published by the MEQ on their online platform, in the student's Academic Record (<https://portail.education.gouv.qc.ca/en/accueil>).**

Please note:

- **Courses may be scheduled in the morning or afternoon, depending on demand and teacher availability. See the included schedule. Daily attendance is required.**
- Students may register for a maximum of two courses. Please fill in the registration form separately for each summer course.
